A Postdoctoral Research Fellowship on the development of light polymerizable materials for resorbable tissue engineering scaffolds is available in the Department of Biomedical Engineering at Case Western Reserve University. The position is available immediately and must be filled as soon as possible. Qualifications:

Competitive candidates who have earned a PhD degree are encouraged to apply for this NIH-funded position. This annual position is renewable, with an optimal duration of two years, and would commence in July 2009. Due to restrictions dictated by the funding source (NIH), the candidate must be a US citizen or permanent resident. The applicant must have completed all of the requirements for their PhD prior to being appointed. This individual must have a strong background and significant experience in polymer chemistry and synthesis. Experience with polymers utilized in tissue engineering is also desirable.
